EDS shipments between the Far East and Germany

The Customer Case

The customer manufactures and markets a wide range of electrical distribution systems (EDS). With their corporate headquarters in Germany, the manufacture of EDS in the Far East posed a challenge for the company due to the distances involved in shipping the products to Europe.

The customer outsourced solution, prior to their collaboration with Nefab, was corrugated packaging, which had poor transport utilisation and high costs. Another solution was needed and Nefab proposed the ideal alternative.

The Nefab Solution

Nefab was able to offer a customised solution according to the customer's requirements. The customer tested several samples under real conditions and they were initially impressed.
